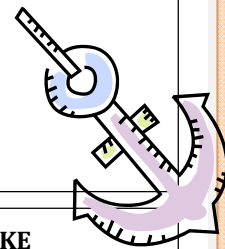
### PORTLAND DUCK TOUR & SEADOGS GAME

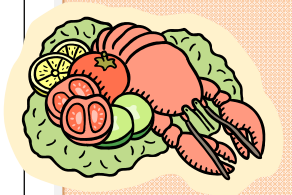
### CABBAGE ISLAND CLAMBAKE

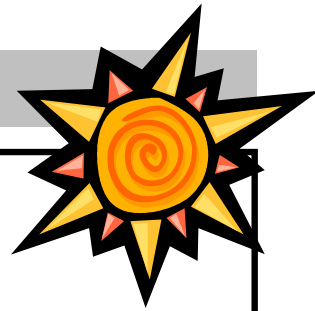

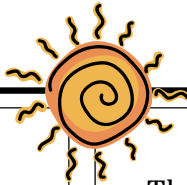

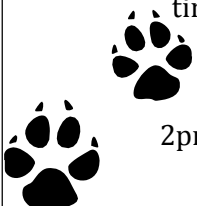
